



## A CHECKLIST OF *Ficus L.* OF BIHAR, JHARKHAND, CHHATTISGARH, MADHYA PRADESH AND WEST BENGAL *Ficus L.* OF BIHAR, JHARKHAND, CHHATTISGARH, MADHYA PRADESH AND WEST BENGAL: A CHECKLIST

### ABSTRACT

The present study provides a checklist of the members of genus *Ficus* found in Bihar, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh and West Bengal. A total of 58 taxa of *Ficus* have been enlisted along with phenology and distribution at district level of each taxa is provided. Eleven taxa are distributed in all the 5 states and maximum number members are found in West Bengal (46 taxa), followed by Jharkhand (25 taxa), Chhattisgarh and Madhya Pradesh (20 taxa each) and Bihar (19 taxa).

### INTRODUCTION

Gasparrini (1945) had subdivided the genus *Ficus* into many genera. Later, Miquel (1867) studied about 550 species recognized at that time and subdivisions were merged. Major work on *Ficus* was done by Corner (1958), he revised Asian, Australian and Malesian *Ficus*. In 1965, he revised classification of the genus and also published a check-list of the Asian and Australian members (Corner, 1965). DeWolf (1960, 1975) worked on neotropical *Ficus* flora in Flora of Panama and Flora of Surinam. Berg (1989, 1990) regrouped the main subdivisions of Corner's classification on the basis of morphological characters, reproduction traits and pollination systems. Structure of reproductive organs and pollination system play significant role in the evolution; therefore, this study is quite helpful in the understanding evolutionary relationship among the members of genus *Ficus*. Berg (1989) has recognized two main group in the genus, first group subgenera *Pharmacosycea* and *Urostigma* are monoecious with pistillate flowers, imperfect heterostylous and filiform stigma. Second group *Sycomorus* and *Sycomorus* is confined to old world, it includes mostly dioecious (except 15 monoecious species), flowers are perfect heterostylous and seeds formed in ovary. According to APG IV system of classification, genus *Ficus* is classified under family Moraceae and order Rosales. World-wide genus *Ficus* has 880 accepted species, more than 500 species of *Ficus* are in Asia and Australia and it is the most diverse flora with dominance of dioecious species, in Africa (including Madagascar and adjacent groups of islands) there are 105 species (Berg, 1989; Chase et al, 2016).

Literature survey shows that first taxonomic account on Indian *Ficus L.* is published by King (1887-88), he recorded 113 species and 47 infraspecific taxa in British India, of them 75 species are from present India. In Bentham and Hooker's (1860) volume, King (1888) had published 112 species in undivided British India (not included 23 names). Some state/UT level publications on enlisting of Indian *Ficus* were made by Khanna (1996), Mudgal et al. (1997), Singh et al. (2001), Pandey and Diwakar (2008) and Lakshminarasimhan et. al. (2019). Indian *Ficus* was enlisted by Chaudhary et al. (2012) and published 115 taxa (89 species and 26 infraspecific taxa), of them only 10 taxa have been recorded as endemic. They divided genus in to six subgenera and 12 sections and documented distribution of the genus at national level. Chaudhary et al. (2012) mentioned that Meghalaya in the North-East region has very rich diversity of *Ficus* as far as the number of species is concerned. Recently, Dash and Mao (2020) have reported 96 species and 12 infraspecific taxa in India. The objective of the present study was to document distribution of the members *Ficus* in the state of Bihar, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh and West Bengal.

### METHODOLOGY

The distribution of *Ficus* was documented with the help of relevant literatures like, Flora of British India (Bentham and Hooker, 1890), A Forest flora of Chotanagpur including Gangpur and the Santal Parganahs – A description of all the indigenous trees, shrubs and climbers, the principal economic herbs, and most common cultivated trees and shrubs (Haines, 1910), The Botany of Bihar and Orissa: An account of all the

known indigenous plants of the province and of the most important or most commonly cultivated exotic ones with maps and introduction (Haines, 1921 – 1925), Moraceae in Madhya Pradesh (Khanna, 1996), Check-list of *Ficus* in Asia and Australasia with keys to identification (Corner, 1965), Flora of Tamil Nadu (Henry et al., 1987), Flowering plants of India: An annotated (Dash and Mao, 2020), Flora of West Bengal (Lakshminarasimhan et al., 2019), Flora of Madhya Pradesh (Mudgal et al, 1997), An Integrated Check - list of Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Pandey and Diwakar, 2008), Flora of Bihar Analysis (Singh et al., 2001). Further, the data was updated and analysis has been done.


## RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Total 56 taxa have been enlisted from Bihar, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh and West Bengal, and two subspecies. Eleven taxa are distributed in all the 5 states these are *Ficus arnottiana*, *Ficus benghalensis*, *Ficus microcarpa*, *Ficus mollis*, *Ficus palmata*, *Ficus racemosa*, *Ficus rigida*, *Ficus semicordata*, *Ficus tinctoria* subsp. *parasitica* and *Ficus virens*. Fig. 1 shows that maximum number members are found in West Bengal (46 taxa), followed by Jharkhand (25 taxa), Chhattisgarh and Madhya Pradesh (20 taxa each) and Bihar (19 taxa). Some of the taxa are economically important, fruits of *Ficus auriculata* are edible, inner bark of *Ficus altissima* are used in paper making, latex of *Ficus benghalensis* is used for rubber making, scale leaves of *Ficus geniculata* are used as vegetables, figs of *Ficus hispida* are used as vegetable, Juice of leaves and young parts of *Ficus religiosa* used as purgative and in skin diseases, *Ficus rumphii* is host of Lac insect, *Ficus virens* bark yield fiber, young shoots are vegetable and fruits are edible. All the 56 taxa are enumerated along with citations, phenology and distribution:
